**II. New Business**

- a. Scouting for Food Pickup and Picnic – We will meet at 10:00AM to begin food pickup. **Leaders should contact their cubs to remind them about this most excellent event. Do not forget those cubs that are not St. Paul School students. This event is scheduled for next weekend November 11<sup>th</sup>.** Dens are responsible for bringing the following to the picnic.  
**Tigers:** Paper plates, plastic utensils, cups, plates, napkins, drink mix, charcoal  
**Wolves:** Desserts  
**Bears:** Side Dishes (potato salad, beans, etc.)  
**Webelos 1:** Chips, Ice and tomatoes/lettuce for burgers  
**Webelos 2:** Salads
- b. Popcorn Distribution - Immediately following the picnic this Saturday, parents and scouts should pickup their popcorn in the school cafeteria. Any popcorn not picked up by the scouts will go home with the respective leader for distribution. Leaders should let their scouts know that even if they do not come to the picnic that they should pickup their popcorn Saturday.
- c. Santa Parade - The parade will be on Saturday December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Richard will be notifying leaders of the specific details when they are known.
- d. PackMaster - We are now using PackMaster to track the activities of our pack and also to track achievements. The data is on a secure server that all leaders can access given the password. For those leaders that were not able to attend the meeting, the installation instructions will be mailed to you.
- e. Leader Training - There are lots of leader training opportunities available. You are encouraged to attend. The specific opportunities are posted on the West Central Council web pages (the link is on our pack web pages). Leaders are encouraged to attend the training.
- f. Ft. DeSoto Campout – The campout is scheduled for March 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>. We will be targeting sites 49-61 and 54-66. We will be seeking 12 sites on Friday and 14-16 sites on Saturday. We will

be asking each leader to reserve 2 campsites on the weekend of November 24-26. The specific sites to be reserved by each leader will be out prior to the "Reservation-athon". Leaders are asked to please put the camp site reservations on their credit cards and submit a receipt to Tracy for reimbursement.
